BEVERAGE SERVICE

We offer full service bars in both the main Club House and the banquet room with a wide variety of beverage choices. We provide coolers and ice at no extra charge. You may pre-purchase beverages for your group and distribute them to your participants in the form of beverage tickets. The beverage tickets can be redeemed in the designated bars prior, during and after golf.

Beverage tickets are \$1.30 each and you can purchase up to six (6) tickets for each person in your outing. **By purchasing beverages, you and your organization become partly responsible for the liquor consumption as stated in the third party liquor liability laws.** Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center encourages responsible drinking at all times and reserves the right to limit the consumption of alcohol.

- (2) tickets = Regular beer
- (3) tickets = Season/Premium Beer
- (3) tickets = Cocktail with well liquor
- (3) tickets = Cocktail with call liquor
- (4) tickets = Martini or Manhattan

Gratuity for beverage service is not included and is up to the discretion of the customers.

If you wish to have a larger cash prize on a particular hole, check with our outing director for exact details. You can have a \$5,000 prize for an added fee of \$170.00 per hole.

Driving Range Usage

For \$2.00 per person, you can offer your guests unlimited range balls prior to the start of play. Range balls will either be given out in the golf shop or baskets of balls will be placed on the range depending on the day and starting time of your event.

Tee Signs and Flags

Professionally produced tee signs can provide that extra edge if you are trying to raise funds for charitable cause. We have access to and can assist you in the production of signs suitable for framing to give to the sponsors of each hole. Golf Sponsorship Flags can increase the value of hole sponsorship to your sponsors. By using flags, you provide unmatched frequency, duration and impact of impressions.



Golf Outing Policies and Procedures

All packages include a shotgun start, crossover start, or straight tee times, depending on available starting times for the date you have chosen. A hole-in-one package is included to celebrate those rare but great shots, along with access to the practice center prior to golf.

1. We require at least 16 people for outing packages that include food from our main menu. All guests must play in foursomes and carts are required. If there are an odd number of players, two groups may have less than four players.
2. 30 Days prior to the event a rough estimate of the number of guests is required.
3. 15 Days prior to the event payment is required for the number of guests attending. (Ex: 60 guests times package price = payment due.) No refunds are given for no-shows.

If payment is made with a credit card there will be a surcharge of 2% for MasterCard/Visa & 3% AX.

4. 3 Days prior to the event is Drop and Add Day. You may increase or decrease the number of guests by 10%. No refunds will be given for no-shows after the 3 days notice. Payment for additional guests is due the day of the event.

5. 2 Days prior to the event you must supply us with a players pairings list by foursomes and their order of tee times.

6. A signed agreement must be returned to us within 10 days of being sent to you. The signed agreement acknowledges the terms of the outing and agreement with the policies regarding procedures, weather and sponsorship activities. Menu choice and sides must be completed at this time.

7. The State of Michigan Liquor Control Commission requires that all alcoholic beverages consumed on our premises must be purchased from Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center. It is the responsibility of the outing organizer to inform the outing participants of the Liquor Control Law; outing participants that violate the Liquor Control Law will be asked to leave the premises and no refund will be issued. All bags are subject to search. Minors will not be allowed to consume alcoholic beverages on our premises at any time.

8. Pace of play: All players are expected to play in a timely manner. Our pace of play is a maximum of 4 hours and 30 minutes. The position of all groups on the golf course should be directly behind the group in front of them.

9. Golf cart policy: Keys to the golf carts are distributed by the Outing Director 15 minutes prior to tee time on a scheduled tee time start, and just prior to the shotgun if a shotgun start is used. We expect golfers to use golf carts in a safe manner and abide by all directions, both written and verbal. Liability for damages to the premises or our golf carts will be charged to the person or company making the golf outing reservation.

10. With the exception of special cakes, all food must be purchased from Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center.

11. Sales tax and room/service charges are included in the price of the meals. Gratuity for beverage service is not included and is up to the discretion of the customers.

12. Outings played Monday through Thursday that use a straight tee time start or a crossover start must complete their tee-off by 12:52 PM and finish turning by 3:15 PM.

13. Shotgun starts are available for any size groups with conditions; Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center will decide how many holes and the placement of teams on the holes. Exclusivity can be arranged for an additional fee; That fee is based on the difference between group participants and 144-players.



Sponsorship Activities

Sponsorships are the lifeblood of many golf outings. We are committed to helping you in having a successful event for your golfers while providing sponsorship opportunities for your supporters. Please read through the following policies and if you have any questions, please ask our outing director to clarify.

Tee and green sponsors: We allow activities that are directly related to the hole in play; such as long drives, closest to the pin, hit your drive in a circle in the fairway, closest to the line, etc. Any other activity would have to be approved in advance. Activities such as chipping balls into boxes, hitting marshmallows, throwing lawn darts, etc. cannot be allowed. These activities slow the pace of play and create excess wear and tear on the grounds.

Signs: All signs must be mounted using wire mounts. Stakes that need to be pounded into the ground with a hammer are normally not acceptable. Use of packaging tape, masking tape, duct tape or staples to mount signs on our posts is not allowed. Our staff is prepared to install and pick-up your tee signs. Please have them at the golf course early.

Equipment: We will supply tables and chairs. A list of the sponsors, hole assignments and their table and chair needs should be supplied to us three days in advance of the event. No portable generators, appliances, boom boxes, etc. will be allowed on the course.

Cart usage by sponsors: All extra carts are provided at our option. Sponsors may use the cart to drive between the hole they are sponsoring and the clubhouse. No more than two adults may be on the cart at one time. No banners, tape or other items may be attached to the carts. At the sponsor holes, the cart must be parked off the cart paths in the long grass, not on the tee surface or green surface. Carts are not allowed in the parking lot unless driven by our staff. All items that must be taken to the holes can be dropped at the bag drop area where our staff will help to accommodate the sponsors. Sponsors should arrive early and drop off their items at the bag drop so our staff can help them get organized and out to their sponsor area.

Alcoholic Beverages: Sponsors may not distribute or redistribute any alcoholic beverage.

Food & Beverage: All food and beverage that sponsors want to distribute to golfers must be purchased through the golf course.

Personal Appearances: Any personal appearances by models, etc. must first be approved by our facility and meet our "family friendly" definition.

Hole-in-one Events: Your outing package includes a hole-in-one package provided by Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center. There are times when you may want a larger prize for this great shot. We can help arrange for larger cash prizes or cars, boats or motorcycles. If your outing has access to a large prize for a hole in one, arrangements for Hole-in-one events must be made in advance. We will make every effort to place the prize such as a car at the specified hole. Weather conditions often dictate if we can take a vehicle weighing several thousand pounds onto the course. We need to have a minimum distance for the hole clearly communicated to us so tee markers can be set accordingly. The sponsor agrees to hold Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center harmless for any dispute that could occur over the use of a hole-in-one event.



Policy on Cancellation Due to Inclement Weather

Unfortunately, inclement weather is something that golf outings and golf courses have to deal with on occasion. During our years of hosting golf outings, Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center has adopted the following policies regarding weather related issues. The policies are intended to protect you and the golf facility. Please read through the following policies and if you have any questions, please ask our outing director to clarify.

1. No refunds will be given based on weather forecasts. If you have an event planned, plan on being at the golf course prior to the event's start time.

2. All weather related issues would be discussed and resolved between our outing director and you, the outing representative. This includes but is not limited to delays in play, suspension of play, restarting of play, rain checks, cancellations and rescheduling.

3. Our outing director will inform you, the outing representative, as soon as possible if the course is going to be closed due to weather related issues. However, in most cases, that decision cannot be made until the planned start time of the event.

4. A delay in the start of play or a suspension in play will occur when severe weather is in the area. The length of the delay or suspension will be determined by the weather and course conditions. Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center reserves the right to delay the start or suspend play of an event up to an hour. In the event of a suspension of play, Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center reserves the right to reduce the amount of holes in order to meet other scheduled commitments and make adjustments to the fee. After that time, an event can be canceled or, if possible, rescheduled.

5. In the event that **Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center** must close the course prior to play starting, the outing group would be entitled to a full refund. In addition, **Scott Lake Golf & Practice Center** will make every effort to reschedule the event to another day but cannot guarantee that the event can be rescheduled.

6. In the event play has started and the course becomes unplayable, if rescheduling the event is not possible, all players would be entitled to a rain check. All rain check transactions will be handled between our outing director and you, the outing representative.

7. If a food program was scheduled, the outing representative could either schedule the food program for a time later in the day, which would allow Scott Lake's staff enough time to prepare the meal, or cancel the meal.
